I. Club Admin

- A. Olin Jams Line Item
 - 1. Asking for \$560. \$400 for storage, \$120 for music stands, \$40 for clocks.
 - 2. Approved
- B. ASME Line Item
 - 1. Asking for \$900 for hovercraft supplies (ASME Design Challenge)
 - 2. Determined that ME stockroom would be a safe and acceptable place for their leftover supplies
 - 3. Approved.
- C. Composer's Consortium Information
 - 1. To avoid conflict with the Composer's Consortium, Olin Jams wants to change their mission to: To promote musical performance and education in the Olin community and to manage the musical resources of the Olin College student body.
 - 2. Mission statement change approved
 - 3. Composer's Consortium
 - a. Mission: The Composer's Consortium would endeavor to promote the composition, extension, and revision of both ensemble and solo music, to promote a dialog between composers and performers in the Olin community, and to provide a forum for composers to help each other in the development of their skills
 - b. President: Paul Mandel
 - c. Change "would endeavor" to "will endeavor." Approved.
- D. Frankly Speaking Line Item
 - 1. Asking for \$200 for publishing costs
 - 2. Approved.
- E. GO Line Item
 - 1. Asking for \$60 for a gift for their speaker
 - 2. Seems to be a "donation to a 3rd party institution" – against policy
 - 3. Discomfort with giving of a gift
 - 4. Gift is in lieu of a speaker fee – seems like a reasonable cost
 - 5. Sent to the GA (no consensus).
